

COSMETIC MOLE REMOVAL WITH RADIO FREQUENCY AFTERCARE

The moles are removed utilising a transfer of energy by radio waves and do not require any cutting or stitches. Once the mole is removed we apply an antibiotic ointment and bandaid/dressing to the area. It will take approximately 2 weeks for the area to settle. You will be given a small amount of ointment to take home. You can shower normally but **DO NOT RUB** the area. Pat the area dry after washing and reapply the ointment and a new bandaid every day for 7 days. If a dressing cannot be affixed (eg. On scalp), apply the ointment 3-4 times per day for 10 days.

After this period, a pink/red mark will remain which should settle down within 3 months but it can sometimes take longer. At this point, leave the area open – make up can be applied if required – and use sunblock every day.
